The ceremony was opened by our CEO Dr Malik Zaben in the presence of a number of distinguished guests including H.E Prof Abu Mowis and his family, the CEO of Augusta Victoria Hospital, Dr Fadi Atrash, and the Dean of School of Nursing at Bethlehem University, Mrs Mariam Abu Awad. Dr Zaben has pointed out that this memorial scholarship is a gesture from IMET2000 to our distinguished Patron Prof Abu Mowis and his family.










Another Successful Autumn Gala October 21,2022 on Zoom

Our CEO Dr Malik Zaben outlined his plans for upgrading healthcare at the Arab-American University of Palestine (AAUP) through research as well as a modernised teaching curriculum in the AAUP Faculty of Medicine. Famous filmmaker Ken Loach was interviewed by humanitarian activist Naomi Wimborne-Idrissi about his style of direction and that was a fascinating conversation. The fun was provided by our two great stand-up comedians Mark Thomas and Imran Yusuf. Further entertainment included beautiful Arabic music sung by Wafaa ElNajili and played on Arabic instruments by young students of the Edward Said National Conservatory of Music Gaza Branch. Finally, Malik and Colin appealed to the audience to help fund three projects: one for child mental health in Palestine; another in supporting medical students from really poor families in the Jenin region, particularly from the Bedouin community; and finally for the IMET2000 programme of eye surgery particularly cataracts in Uganda. We thank Harriet Paul for superb organisation, Charles Phillips for well-rehearsed compering of the programme and Jojo Zaben for ensuring the event ran without a single glitch technically. 





IMET2000 Completed Its Second Research Club Programme this October: Attended by more than 200 Participants


Our branch in Palestine (IMET2000-Pal) has completed seven webinars on: "clinical audit, how to formulate your research question, research methodology, systematic review, data collection and analysis, academic writing and result dissemination and how to read a paper and to avoid plagiarism under the umbrella of our launched Research Club. These webinars were attended by more than 200 participants in each session of healthcare professionals and students from Palestine. It was delivered by our CEO, Dr Malik Zaben and other researchers from the UK and coordinated by Dr Alaa Salameh- the medical education officer at IMET2000-Pal.

The participants were taken through the importance of research in health before Dr Zaben pointed out the key benefits of healthcare professionals involved in research. The webinars were closed by taking many questions from the participants. These webinars will be followed by hands-on sessions wherein participants will be closely supervised to develop their own research projects. Dr Zaben pointed out that "IMET2000 has allocated the needed funds to develop its Research Club to international standards. This Club will be a hub to deliver much-needed relevant and interesting research projects for Palestine and the area.

explores new and creative education models that support the development of best practices and facilitate interdisciplinary research across the cancer care continuum. The conference will improve understanding of how robust community engagement and effective patient navigation impact cancer and cancer education outcomes, alleviate health inequities and increase health literacy. It was an honour for me as a medical student to present my abstract that was titled "Knowledge of ovarian cancer symptoms among women in Palestine: a national cross-sectional study at this conference. In addition, my abstract has been published in the journal of cancer education. I presented my abstract for one hour and a half on Friday, 14 October. Also, I attended other conference programs on Wednesday, 12 October and Thursday, 13 October. IMET2000 Organised Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support Training Workshop at IMET Training Centre

IMET2000-Pal held a workshop covering advanced cardiopulmonary resuscitation that was attended by 7 doctors and Nurses from different hospitals. It was titled:

Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) Course for Physicians and Nurses

The workshop was opened by Mrs Emaa who welcomed the attendees and outlined different events organised by IMET2000. The workshop was directed by Mr Ahmad Houdrob a reliable instructor from the American Heart Association. The training involved the use of medical dolls which helped educate the trainees on how to perform advanced cardiac resuscitation on patients that needed immediate aid and allowed them to practice it. This was alongside a scientific and practical explanation provided by the instructors. At the end of the second day, the trainees were assessed to measure their ability in dealing with such cases.
