## IMET2000-Pal organised number of trainings in Anaesthesia Programme



In cooperation between IMET2000-PAL and WFSA, Dr Abdulsatar Ravalia an anaesthesiologist from UK conducted 2 weeks of hands-on training as part of our anaesthesia-training program. This scheme aims to support safe global anaesthesia and to help Palestinian anaesthetists in their ability to use existing ultrasound equipment to offer regional anaesthesia techniques to their adult and paediatric patients. Dr Abdulsatar visited 4 hospitals including AL-Makased Hospital, Palestine Medical Complex (PMC) Rafedia Hospital, Hebron Hospital.

## Master of Science in physiotherapy Scholarship, Nottingham University



Bashar Ayaseh, the Head of Physiotherapy Department at St. Joseph Hospital, Jerusalem, was granted a scholarship by IMET 2000 to study Masters of Physiotherapy (Neuro Rehabilitation) at the University of Nottingham. Mr. Ayaseh is expected to graduate in September 2018 and will be the first physiotherapist specializing in Neuro Rehabilitation in Palestine.
