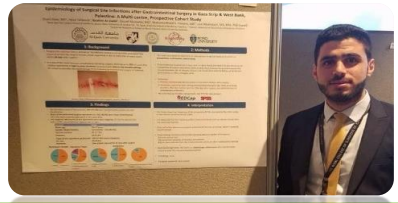
Basic Life Support (BLS) for Nurses Session 13
