### IMET2000-Pal Organized Training Session for Doctors and Nurses on Basic Life Support (BLS) - Session II

The Department of Continuous Education at IMET2000-Pal and in cooperation with the Palestinian Ministry of Health organized another training course for doctors and nurses working in Hebron Governmental Hospital in the presence of 28 doctors and nurses. The workshop aimed to help doctors and nurses identify the latest developments and applications of CPR applied to children and adults. The course was led by Mr. Osaid Rasheed/ lecturer at Al-Quds University, Dr. Salah Al-Tameezi / Specialist Doctor in the emergency department at the hospital, and Ms. Iman Abu Kheran/ legal trainer nurse. It focused on theoretical and practical aspects of BLS and as per the American Heart Association (AHA) 2015 guidelines. Participants were also trained on how to embrace CPR techniques during resuscitation setting.
