Infection Prevention and Control for Physicians and Nurses Training: Central Line-Associated Bloodstream Infection (CLABSI) and Ventilator Association Pneumonia (VAP) - Session Two

IMET2000 organised the second workshop of infection control and prevention for physicians and nurses on Central Line-Associated Bloodstream Infection (CLABSI) and Ventilator Association Pneumonia (VAP). It was attended by more than 35 doctors and nurses working in intensive care units in Palestine and led by Dr. Rabee Odwan/ infectious disease specialist at Al-Makassed hospital.

This initiative is designed for physicians and nurses from the governmental and private hospitals of different districts in the West Bank, particularly those working at the critical departments. The training focused on the principles of infection control and prevention measures for CLABSI and VAP according to Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and National Healthcare Safety Network (NHST) guidelines.

Finally, Mr. Fadi Zaben/ Head of Continuing Education Department at IMET2000-Pal said that “we will continue organising similar workshops to offer training for all those working on medical field”.



ACLS Workshop – Session Two

In collaboration with the Palestinian Ministry of Health (MoH) as part of our critical care training program for physicians and nurses, we organised a second workshop on “Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) “. The workshop had 14 doctors and nurses working in intensive, operation and emergency units in Hebron Governmental Hospital in Palestine. IMET200 will continue organizing similar training to offer training for all health care providers in Palestine.
