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## IMET2000 Fundraising Dinner 2018



The International Medical Education Trust (IMET2000) organized a fundraising dinner at the House of Lords, London on the 2nd of February. This event was organized to support the activities and programs in Medical education. Baron Jenni Tong, a former member of the House of Lords, hosted the dinner. Professor Colin Green, the treasurer & founder of IMET2000, pointed out the importance of supporting the programs and projects of IMET2000 and its positive impact on medical education in Palestine. Dr Nizam Najeeb, chief of the Palestinian Medical Association, was guest of honour at the dinner. He stressed on the importance of developing health programs in Palestine and the need to prepare more Palestinian competencies for long-term training. Dr Malik Zaben asked support for a number of important projects and programs, particularly in neurosurgery, rehabilitation and neurorehabilitation, as well as the establishment of the first training centre for doctors in dealing with serious traumatic injuries (ATLS) and residency training in child psychiatry. At the end of the event, Dr Zaben and Professor Colin Green thanked the donors and the attendees for their cooperation, efforts and outstanding response to our needs.



## Support the Development of Disordered Children in Jerusalem Wall Sides



In collaboration with Rawan Association for Child Development, IMET 2000-Pal organised two workshops for teachers and social workers. The first workshop was at Al-Ram Secondary School/ Al-Ram, while the second was at Al-Jeeb Secondary School/ Beir Nabala on February 12th and 19th 2018, respectively. 20 teachers and social workers attended at each. Mrs Salam Asia /CEO of Rawan Association led on both workshops. The training focused on certain topics like autism, dyslexia, ADHD, capacity building & coaching (upgrade and enhance the service providers' skills). In addition, the attendees were trained on how to increase the awareness and support children with above mentioned disorders, limit their suffering and provide them with early detection, and diagnosis services.
