## “Infection Prevention and Control Training: Practical Guidelines for Infection Control in Health Care Facilities”

IMET2000-Pal organised a training event for nursing students, focused on infection prevention and control, in Bethlehem /Qubeibeh branch in Ramallah. 30 nursing students attended the training. The course was led by Mr Fadi Zaben, the head of the General Education Department at IMET2000-Pal. It focused on theoretical and practical aspects of infection prevention and control principles, basic methods of prevention, types of patient isolation, and ways to prevent or reduce the risk of hospital-acquired infections. This course aims to equip nursing students with the infection control foundations they need as future practicing nurses.
