Emergency Nursing Core Training: Basic Electrocardiogram Interpretation (ECG)-Session IV

August 18, 2018; IMET 2000-PAL in cooperation with Palestinian Nursing and Midwifery Association-Bethlehem branch organised the Emergency Nursing Core Training: Basic Electrocardiogram Interpretation (ECG). It is designed for critical care nurses who are working in the emergency, medical, and critical departments. Also, it aims to describe the normal cardiac anatomy and physiology and normal electrical conduction through the heart, identify and relate waveforms to the cardiac cycle, understand the different lead placements and purpose of each placement, and recognize sinus, atrial, junctional and ventricular dysrhythmia on ECG, and relate cause, significance, symptoms and treatment. The workshop was attended by 30 nurses from governmental and private hospitals in Bethlehem. This workshop was led by Mr. Abed Al-Kreem Asakra.
