Workshop on how to approach children with learning difficulty and Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD)

IMET2000-Pal organized a workshop aimed primarily to train Rawan's Association's members of staff. Dr Hasanen Al-Taia; our UK guest and member of the Board of Trustees led the workshop. Dr AlTatia is also a consultant psychiatrist & Tutor at Oxford Health NHS Foundation Trust. Over the course of 2-days, topics primarily related to autistic spectrum disorder, attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD) and learning disability were extensively addressed. Special attention was particularly paid to practical aspects of approaching children with those disorders in relation to day-to-day practice.
