- Clinical Skills – Teaching & Assessment (OSCE, standard setting, Grading practices (to sum or not to sum))

- Community – Based Education and Health Professions Education.
- Teaching One – to –One: one minute preceptor & Assessment.
- Skilled Educational planner: Integration & Coherence, outcomes competency, Blueprinting. Planning strategies, Curriculum models.
