IMET2000 Signs a Memorandum of Understanding with Nablus University for Vocational and Technical Education

IMET2000 has signed a memorandum of understanding with Nablus University for Vocational and Technical Education, reflecting the shared commitment of both institutions to strengthening academic and professional partnerships aimed at developing health education in Palestine.

The agreement was signed at the campus of Nablus University. It was signed on behalf of IMET2000 by Prof Malik Zaben, CEO of IMET2000, and on behalf of the University by Prof Dirar Elayan, President of the University.

The agreement aims to support continuing education and professional training in areas such as clinical skills, mental health, trauma care, and scientific research. It also provides learning and training opportunities for nursing students to improve their practical skills and preparedness for work.

Both parties emphasised the importance of this partnership in enhancing the quality of nursing education and supporting students, graduates, and academic staff through joint programmes and shared expertise.

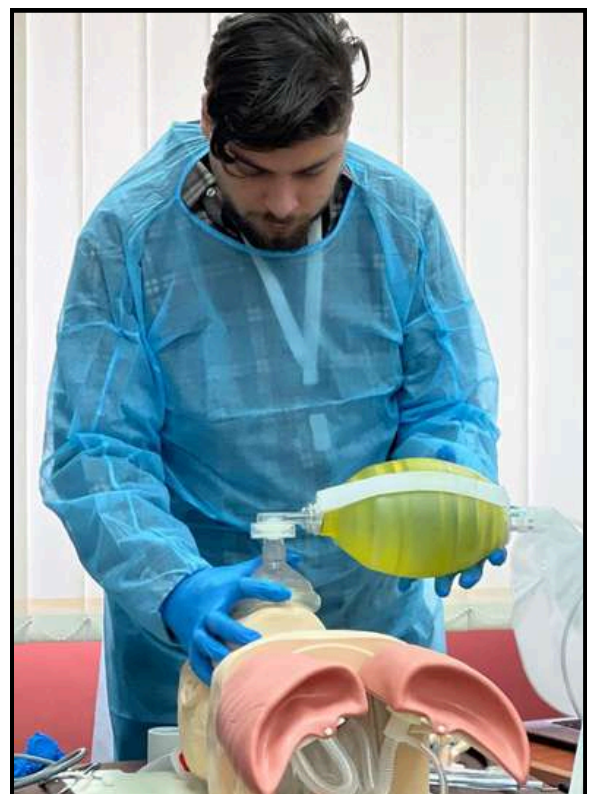


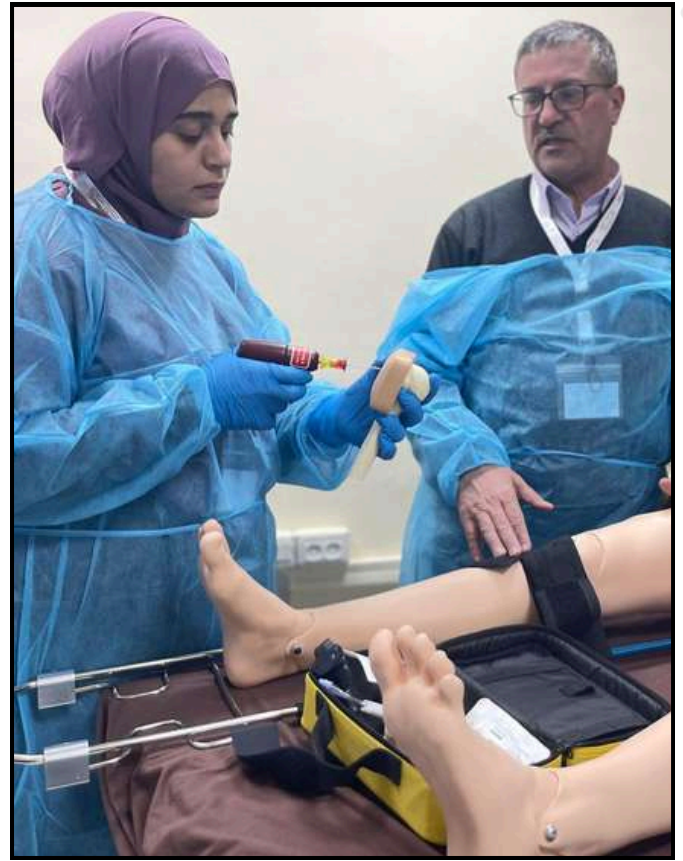
IMET2000 Organises Advanced Trauma Life Support (ATLS) Training Course for Palestinian Doctors



In Palestine, trauma and severe injuries represent a daily challenge for healthcare professionals. With the support of IMET2000, a specialised **Advanced Trauma Life Support (ATLS) training course**, accredited by the American College of Surgeons, was delivered to strengthen doctors' skills in managing critical cases.

The training was delivered over three consecutive days, from 21 to 23 January 2026, at the IMET2000-Pal Training Centre in Ramallah. A total of 16 doctors from various governmental and private Palestinian hospitals participated in the course.





The course began with two days of advanced theoretical lectures, followed by intensive hands-on training under certified instructors from the American College of Surgeons. Participants focused on rapid patient assessment, prioritising interventions, and delivering life-saving care. The third day concluded with both theoretical and practical assessments.



IMET2000-Pal Conducts Two Basic Life Support Training Workshops

In critical situations, the possession of appropriate skills can be decisive in saving lives. In this context, IMET2000-Pal conducted two specialised training workshops titled **“Critical Core Training: Basic Life Support (BLS) Training for Healthcare Professionals.”**

The workshops aimed to equip healthcare professionals with essential theoretical knowledge and hands-on skills in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) for adults, children, and infants, alongside practical training on the safe and effective use of Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs).

The workshops were delivered by certified instructors accredited by the American Heart Association (AHA), the training ensured participants received up-to-date, standardised instruction aligned with international guidelines.

The workshops were held on 5 January at the IMET2000-Pal Training Centre in Ramallah and on 12 January at Friends Medical Creativity Centre in Nablus, with the participation of 18 doctors and nurses.

IMET2000 Empowers Dura Al-Amal Charity Specialists with HeartSaver® and First Aid Skills

IMET2000 organised a specialised training workshop entitled “HeartSaver® First Aid Training for Care Providers”, targeting professionals working with children with special needs at Dura Al Amal Charity.



The workshop was held on 10 January 2026, at Dura Al-Amal Charity in Hebron, and brought together 16 specialists and staff members. It focused on strengthening participants’ preparedness and confidence in dealing with emergencies, ensuring their ability to respond quickly and safely to incidents involving children or colleagues.

The training combined practical, hands-on exercises with guided instruction delivered by AHA-certified trainers. Participants were trained in essential first aid techniques through realistic scenarios, reinforcing theoretical knowledge and enabling them to apply life-saving skills effectively in real-life emergencies.



IMET2000 Signs Memorandum of Understanding with Beacon of Excellence



IMET2000 has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Beacon of Excellence for Consulting, Training, and Professional Development.

The agreement aims to enhance medical and health education for Palestinian doctors, enrich regional and international partnerships, and create opportunities for knowledge exchange with global institutions. The signing ceremony was attended by Prof Malik Zaben, CEO of IMET2000, and Dr Eyad Ghanimat, CEO of Beacon of Excellence.

Both parties emphasised the partnership's role in advancing professional training and building healthcare capacity, particularly in specialised areas such as advanced respiratory care.

The MoU establishes a framework for future initiatives, including advanced training programmes and initiatives aligned with international standards, contributing to improved healthcare quality and sustainable development in the region.



IMET2000 Hosts Paediatric Advanced Life Support Training Workshop for Health Care Professionals

As part of its ongoing training activities, IMET2000-Pal held a “Paediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS) Training Workshop for Healthcare Professionals” on 13-14 January 2026 at the An-Najah Training Centre in Nablus, with the participation of six doctors and nurses from various governmental and private hospitals in the West Bank.



The workshop was delivered by Dr Fadi Zaben, IMET2000-Pal Representative and a certified instructor by the American Heart Association (AHA).

The training focused on key components of paediatric emergency care, including updates from the American PALS guidelines. Participants engaged in practical sessions covering the paediatric systematic approach, high-quality CPR for infants and children, management of respiratory and cardiac emergencies, and early intervention strategies. The course also included training in multi-rescuer resuscitation techniques and team dynamics.



IMET2000 Organises Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support Training for Paramedics at IMET2000-Pal Training Centre

Recognising the critical needs for up-to-date clinical competencies in emergency care, IMET2000-Pal organised a specialised training workshop on advanced cardiopulmonary resuscitation for paramedics at IMET2000-Pal Training Centre

The two-day workshop, held on 26-27 January 2026, was attended by six paramedics representing various hospitals.



The workshop addressed key components of advanced cardiopulmonary resuscitation, including the management of respiratory and cardiac arrest, symptomatic bradycardia, airway management, acute stroke care, and ACLS-related pharmacology. In addition to clinical skills, the training highlighted the importance of effective communication and leadership within ACLS teams, aiming to enhance coordinated and timely decision-making during high-acuity emergencies.
